

# DE-ESCALATING ON THE FRONT LINE WITH 40MM PROJECTILE LAUNCHERS

Safety, accuracy, and cost-effectiveness differentiate this new tool

Law Enforcement in Canada and the United States are adopting a highly successful new method for safely de-escalating high risk situations by using impact rounds fired from a 40mm launcher. The launchers are being used as a complement to the standard Conducted Energy Weapons (CEW), also known as TASERTM weapons carried by law enforcement professionals every day around the country. The 40mm launcher and impact rounds (see image below) provide Police users with a dramatically improved ability to safely address threats at longer range. 40mm systems and ammunition are cost effective to acquire and maintain. Additionally, they are not subject to the same situations that can cause CEW weapons to fail.





A 40mm single shot launcher and impact round from Defense Technology. A 40mm launcher is a special-purpose firearm designed to launch 40mm projectiles. 40mm projectiles are low velocity rounds available in a variety of payloads.

A major limitation of a CEW is its maximum effective engagement range of 10 meters. 40mm projectiles by contrast have an effective range of 40 meters. By extending this range of less lethal capabilities, Police users no longer need to be in such close proximity to their subject. This not only reduces risk to the Police user, it also reduces the potential for a physical altercation where use of deadly force becomes necessary. Police users can establish a safe distance, work to develop lines of communication and increase the chance of a peaceful resolution.

The launcher's force is the equivalent of getting struck by a baseball traveling about 65 kmph, or the speed of a ball thrown by a little leaguer, meaning that, if it must be used, the most likely injury a person could sustain from the launcher is bruising, swelling and physical discomfort.

"The more we can get these less-lethal rounds in the hands of our officers, the less likely that bad scenarios will continue to deteriorate to the point where the only option left is lethal force," quoted Madison Wisconsin Police Chief Mike Koval in an interview with local paper, the Wisconsin State Journal.

# DE-ESCALATING ON THE FRONT LINE WITH 40MM PROJECTILE LAUNCHERS

In many cases, 40mm launchers are replacing 12 Gauge Shotguns that fire bean bag munitions. 12 guage rounds are less accurate and distribute their energy over a smaller area, increasing the chance of injuring the subject. An additional benefit of the 40mm launcher is that is can be outfitted with accessories, like a red dot optical sight to further improve accuracy.

Another important consideration is cost. The 40mm launcher is far less expensive to operate and train with than a CEW. The service life of a well maintained 40mm launcher could easily exceed 10+ years, this offers a great deal of value and cost savings to any agency. Additionally, 40mm ammunition is readily available from multiple suppliers, cost effective and is purely mechanical with no expensive batteries or cartridges to replace.

The challenges facing frontline professionals have never been more profound. Progressive tools like the 40 mm launcher add a safe, efficient, and cost-effective option for Canadian Police users.

# MINIATURE RED DOT SIGHTS FOR GENERAL DUTY POLICING

# The benefits that police are seeing by adapting this modern technology

Miniature Red Dot sights (MRDS) on pistols are quickly being adapted by forward-thinking law enforcement agencies who are discovering the range of benefits offered by adding an optic to a duty pistol. As more data is published, mounting evidence clearly shows that MRDS enhance the safety and accuracy of law enforcement pistols, improve situational awareness and are more effective when used in high stress situations.



The AIMPOINT ACRO-P2 (pictured above) is a popular example of Miniature Red Dot Sights (MRDS) being adopted by modern law enforcement.

MRDS have been used by special operations forces, tactical teams, and in competitive shooting sports for years. Now with further advancements in durability, battery life, duty holster compatibility and OEM duty pistol compatibility (GLOCK MOS), MRDS have quickly become a viable option for general duty use. As more agencies begin to adopt MRDS optics, the true benefits to usability and police user safety are becoming very apparent.

When the human body is subject to stress, the Sympathetic Nervous System (SNS) initiates a variety of responses that prime the body to defend itself or escape danger. One of the first activations by SNS is to the eyes: our field of vision is increased to it's maximum, pupils are dilated to intake more visual information, and the Ciliary muscles (the ring of muscles that surround the lens of the eye) contract, which thickens the lens for better distant focus.

This reaction has served a critical role in mankind's survival throughout history, but when operating a firearm, it can make it extremely difficult to find your sights and acquire sight picture under extreme stress or spontaneous threat<sup>1</sup>. When using an MRDS, your eyes are able to remain in a more natural and open state, which allows for less reliance on 'fine' focus, ultimately better compensating for these involuntary physiological changes. The wider and clearer target picture allows for a much easier sight to acquire under stress.







A comparison between an MRDS sight picture and traditional irons.

Predictably, the human brain also has its own reaction to a stress response triggered by our SNS. Under extreme stress our brain modifies the way it takes in information. Specifically, it prioritizes the volume of information taken in over the accuracy of the information taken in². Under high stress, our brains cannot process as much detail in the visual data it takes in, which can cause the mind to make presumptive leaps, or 'fill in the blanks³. This is especially true in low-light scenarios⁴. The human brain can incorrectly complete a pattern or misinterpret an object, like mistaking a floor lamp for a person, or a cellphone for a pistol. This can present an extremely dangerous scenario where police users can make a 'mistake-of-fact-shooting', where the police user makes an honest mistake where they believed that use of lethal force was justified. MRDS with their wider focal plane and bright powered red dot allows the police user to greatly increase the amount of information they are able to take in about their surroundings while retaining sight picture. This additional situational awareness can mitigate some of the presumptive thinking our brains are prone to under extreme stress. In moments where quick decisions need to be made, having additional visual data available to the police user can help make better, more informed decisions and improve both situational awareness and accuracy under stress.

### MINIATURE RED DOT SIGHTS FOR GENERAL DUTY POLICING

These are just some of the ways MRDS can help police better protect the public with technology. As more and more agencies adopt MRDS, and as more data is released, the benefits of an MRDS for both public and police user safety are becoming common knowledge. Thier improvements to accuracy, benefits to situational awareness, and better compensation to our physiological responses to stress present a clear advantage over traditional pistol iron sights.

# NO SUCH THING AS A ROUTINE CALL: SCENARIO BASED TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

One of the primary goals for any modern police force is to provide realistic, effective training that prepares officers for real-world situations. This is critically important not only for officer safety, but also for maintaining public trust.

There are a number of different ways that police forces can achieve this goal. One particularly effective approach is situational role-playing; which is training designed to produce an authentic, safe and dynamic replication of the operational environment. This type of reality-based training is being quickly adopted by law enforcement agencies to help officers hone their skills and develop better judgment when faced with real-world situations.

# **ACTION & DECISION MAKING UNDER STRESS**

Ballistic training rounds and scenario based training can test law enforcement users in stressful and rapidly evolving situations that can span the entire use of force continuum. Stress on the trainee can be increased through the actions of role players and through the perceived potential for pain if shot with a ballistic training round. Ballistic training rounds, while remaining non lethal, are painful to be struck with and can leave welts or break skin. This potential for pain further drives the effectiveness of the training, because a fear of getting hit with a ballistic training round can influence police users to change their tactics and exhibit behaviours they may not otherwise show in a more controlled environment.

When adrenaline is up and users are being brought into these simulated encounters, weaknesses in training are quickly exposed. Skills that are not conditioned to the level of unconscious proficiency are revealed, and in the end this pressure results in a much more effective and applicable training experience.

# PROTECTION PROTOCOLS & STANDARDS

Stress induced by role players and the pain penalty of getting hit is part of the training realism, but the participants must be responsibly protected from any serious damage. The head, face and neck are specific areas that require full protection, both from projectiles and from bump impacts. There have been many reports of serious injuries to police users wearing insufficient training equipment, or undisciplined use of gear during force-on-force training. Something as simple as lifting a visor to wipe away fog has in the past resulted in the loss of an eye for one law enforcement user.

# WHENEVERY SECOND COUNTS: LAW ENFORCEMENT & WATER RECUE

From coast to coast to coast, Canada is blessed with extensive water resources that have helped the country flourish and given Canadians a wealth of recreational opportunities. Whether it's ocean ports, the large population centres on the Great Lakes and the St Lawrence, the cottage country of the Muskokas and Laurentians, the prairie cities straddling swift-flowing rivers, or suburban areas dotted with ponds and swimming pools, Canada is built on and alongside water.

But where people and water mix, accidents will happen. Every year, several hundred Canadians die from accidental and preventable drowning. In addition, there are hundreds more non-fatal drownings that cause emergency room visits, hospitalizations, disabilities, and other negative and costly health outcomes. Tragically, many of these drownings involve children aged nine years and younger.



For the emergency service workers tasked with responding to drowning incidents and injuries, each second could mean the difference between life and death. They cannot wait for a specialized water-rescue team: first-responding front-line officers need water-rescue equipment readily available so that they can quickly act.


Law Enforcement agencies should equip their officers with dependable water-rescue equipment that's designed with this urgency in mind. The personal flotation devices (PFDs) and water rescue kits from Mustang Survival can give Law Enforcement agencies confidence that their officers can quickly and safely intervene in water-related emergencies—and save lives.

# **DROWNINGS IN CANADA**

Drowning is the third leading cause of accidental death worldwide, with only unintentional poisoning (such as drug overdose) and motor vehicle accidents causing more accidental deaths. According to the Canadian Drowning Prevention Coalition (1), approximately 460 people fatally drown in Canada each year, with many more suffering non-fatal injuries. In Ontario alone, each year there is an average of 164 deaths, 100 hospitalizations, and 568 emergency department visits from drowning (2).

The majority of fatalities due to drowning occur on natural bodies of water and 10–20% in swimming pools. With Canada's all-too-short summers, it's no surprise that approximately 70% of drownings occur between May and September. In Ontario and Quebec, drownings most frequently occur during aquatics (30%), boating (20%), and unintentional falls into water (15–25%). The most common risk factors for drowning are not wearing a PFD, alcohol consumption, and being alone in the water. Children are particularly at risk of drowning due to a lack of understanding of the dangers of water, inability to swim, smaller lungs, and poor coordination, with the greatest risk factor being absent or distracted supervision.



## WHY LAW ENFORCEMENT NEEDS WATER-RESCUE EQUIPMENT

Despite how common these water-related emergencies are, many Law Enforcement agencies lack immediate access to rescue equipment to intervene in time to save the lives of people drowning.

Even among skilled swimmers, in cold water swim failure can occur in as few as 10 minutes (3). Once swim failure occurs, someone drowning will struggle to keep their airway clear of water before submersion and breath-holding begins. Within seconds, the person drowning will then begin aspirating water and become deprived of oxygen. Absent oxygen, unconsciousness occurs followed by cardio-respiratory arrest. This whole process can happen within minutes, with the possibility of irreversible brain damage occurring within 4–6 minutes of submersion. Hospitalizations and permanent disabilities are very common from drowning. In drowning situations, every second counts, and a fast-acting police officer with proper water-rescue equipment can make all the difference in outcome.

Because of these serious consequences, the costs of drowning incidents, both fatal and non-fatal, are enormous. In 2018 alone, drownings cost Canada \$191 million. A small investment in outfitting officers with water-rescue equipment can greatly reduce these costs and the liability of Law Enforcement agencies.

It's crucial that Law Enforcement officers have accessible and reliable equipment, not only to save other people's lives, but to ensure their own safety. It is common for well-meaning rescuers to also face drowning risks from attempting rescues without a PFD and other appropriate water-rescue equipment. With the proper equipment at hand, these risks can be eliminated.

### **EQUIPMENT RECOMMENDATIONS**

The most essential piece of equipment for water rescue is a Personal Flotation Device. PFDs keep officers safe and afloat while they attempt a rescue. Mustang Survival's line of Law Enforcement PFD's, such as the Compact Tactical Life Preserver or the Heavy Duty Law Enforcement HIT Inflatable PFD, feature their award-winning Hydrostatic Inflator Technology (HIT).

PFDs with hydrostatic inflators have several advantages for Law Enforcement. They only activate when submerged under 10 cm (4 in.) of water, preventing accidental inflation due to humidity, rain, or water splashing over the vest. Hydrostatic inflators require actual water pressure to activate. In contrast, other PFDs use bobbin (salttab) inflators that can deteriorate over time and prematurely dissolve, especially in humid environments, leading to accidental inflation or a failure to deploy. Hydrostatic inflators also have a longer service life than salt-tab inflators. A salt-tab inflator needs replacing every 1–3 years whereas Mustang's HIT inflators have a much longer 5-year maintenance interval—meaning fewer replacements and less-frequent servicing.



A convenient way to provide officers with everything they need to perform a water rescue is to equip Law Enforcement vehicles with Mustang's Water Rescue Kit (MRK110). This kit features a M.I.T.100 Inflatable PFD, a Rescue Stick™ to stabilize someone who is drowning and provide 35 lb of buoyancy, and a throw bag to safely retrieve the person being rescued. # THE DANGERS OF LEAD EXPOSURE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT

Lead exposure in law enforcement is a dangerous and often overlooked thread to police users. At the shooting range it is standard for police users to wear hearing protection and eye protection, but far too often, insufficient precautions are being taken to mitigate lead exposure. With the frequency of firearm training, officers (and subsequently their families) can be exposed to lead on a consistent basis due to the "take home" nature of lead. Lead can remain on your hands and clothes long after your range session and become a continuous source of exposure if not properly cleaned.

# LEAD EXPOSURE AT SHOOTING RANGES

A review of lead exposure at shooting ranges was published in the National Library of Medicine, where they examined 36 studies on lead exposures at shooting ranges [1]. The studies primarily focused on before-after comparisons of shooters, particularly shooters in law enforcement and military. The review concluded that nearly all of the participants in the 36 studies had elevated blood lead levels (BLL) above what is considered safe by the CDC and NIOSH. The average BLL among adults is 0.92 micrograms per decilitre (µg/dl)[2]. Blood lead levels above 5µg/dl is the case definition for an elevated blood level. Full results can be see on the chart below. As your body processes lead in the bloodstream, your BLL's will naturally go down, but consistent and sustained exposure combined with BLL's above 5µg/dL is where health complications from lead poisoning occurs.

Lead dust lingers in the air and collects on shooters' hands and clothing. There are many factors that can help reduce lead exposure at shooting ranges, including respirators, suppressors, and improved ventilation. However, lead that remains on skin or clothing can be both ingested and inhaled by eating, rubbing your nose, mouth, or eyes without properly cleaning your hands. When it comes to removing lead from your hands and clothing, regular soaps and detergents are not sufficient.

Why is just washing your hands with regular soap and water not sufficient? Lead is difficult to wash off. Lead is heavy, sticky, difficult to wet and holds a static charge. All these factors make it adhere strongly to your skin, clothes, shoes, and gloves. Lead reacts with most soaps to form a soap scum, where instead of washing off the lead, you end up gluing it to the surface you are trying to clean. Typical skin cleaners only remove between 30-70% of lead from the skin. Long-term understanding of lead exposure and the increase in reported lead poisoning cases amongst law enforcement have led to companies like ESCA Tech to develop their line of lead cleaning products that remove over 98% of lead from the skin/clothes. 
